

# Ski 'n Do 2022



The Ski 'n Do committee of Oslo Scottish Country Dance Group hereby invites you to join us at the Ski 'n Do 2022 during the weekend of 25 - 27 February 2022 at Kobberhaughytta lodge in the woods north of Oslo.

**What is the Ski 'n Do?** It is an informal weekend where we ski and have a do. A rough outline of the 'program' is as follows:

- Friday: We ski (8 km) or walk (5 km) to the venue. We have dinner, and we do some Scottish country dancing.
- Saturday: We have breakfast, you spend the day as you would like, outdoors or indoors, skiing, snow shoeing, walking, reading, talking, playing games; we have dinner and then we party (which basically means more SCD)!
- Sunday: Breakfast, and then you are free to do what you want. You can ski or you can walk, and eventually find your way home. The Ski 'n Do is over.

The Ski 'n Do is a very informal get-together and the venue is relatively primitive. Do not expect private rooms, do not expect en suite bathrooms. Do expect a lot of fun.

**How to get there:** By T-bane (metro) line 2 westbound to Røa and bus 41 to Sørkedalen Skole and walk up from there, or T-bane line 1 to Voksenkollen and ski in from there. (More detailed instructions will follow.) There is free parking at both places if you are driving. Skiing and walking both take about 1½ hour.

**Costs:** Unfortunately this doesn't come for free, so there will be a charge of NOK 2400 (plus 170 for the bedsheets and towels if needed), payable on arrival. This includes breakfasts, dinners, and accommodation at the lodge. You make your own lunch pack at breakfast. If you need skis, we can help you to find a set to rent at a reasonable price (possibly even for free, but we'll have to check that option).

**What to wear:** This is not a place for being elegantly dressed. Bring warm winter clothes for the outdoor activities and informal clothes for indoors. The odd kilt, however, is guaranteed to be a success in the evenings or even skiing in for the brave. **Everything you bring should fit in a rucksack/backpack which you can carry.**

This is a preliminary invitation. There are details yet to be settled. However, we hope we have tickled your fancy and that you will put the Ski 'n Do in your calendar. The dancing hall is limited to 30 dancers and **we will need a committing 'Yes' (or 'No' if you can't come) from you as soon as possible.
